## Medical/Dental Outpatient Flow

The outpatient ward at Kyushu University Hospital is divided into east and west floors, and each floor has a block reception desk for multiple departments. The block reception desk confirms the arrival of patients, insurance cards, and the completion of consultations/examinations.

The basic flow of patients' consultations/examinations is: After completing procedures at the first visit reception desk or using the return visit check-in machine on the 1st floor of the outpatient ward, patients go through the block reception desk before seeing a doctor.



## First Visit Flow

Please bring your "appointment sheet", "referral (medical report)" and "CD/film images" received from your family doctor, together with your "health insurance card" when you come to the hospital.
